



Carillion, has been selected as the contractor for Kent County Council's New Line Learning Academy and preferred bidder for the Kent Batched Academies programme, worth a total of £118 million. This exciting project delivered through Partnerships for Schools' National Academies Framework involves the design and construction delivery of 5 large secondary education facilities throughout the county of Kent. The work is being managed from our West Malling office.

## About the project

The New Line Learning Academy is a £25m construction scheme. The 18 month project will involve the redevelopment of a new academy building with associated sports building and facilities, circulatory access roads, strategic landscaping works and car park facilities. Demolition works of the existing academy will take place on completion.

## Progress update

- Brick and block work has progress well with the majority of the external façade now complete. This in turn has allowed removal of the scaffolds.
- The glazing and curtain waling is nearing completion.
- The roof works are substantially complete which has provided a partially watertight building.
- Mechanical and electrical installation has commenced along with the construction of the internal walls.
- Overall we are pleased to record that the project is currently on programme.
- 12 months have past without any reportable accidents, RIDDOR free.

## How we manage our waste

Managing our waste is an important element in ensuring that the site is operating to a high environmental standard. We aim to minimise waste generated by site in the first place by working with our supply chain to take action such as reducing packaging and off cuts. Our key aim for any waste generated on site is that it does not go to landfill so we try to ensure that as near to 100% as possible is either reused or recycled.
